

# Recycled Art: Tissue or Cereal Box Guitar

## Materials

- Tissue box
- 4-5 rubber bands
- Markers, paint, paper, gems, glue, stickers, and any decorations you want to use
- **\*\*OPTIONAL:** A paper towel roll for the “neck of the guitar”, you will also then need scissors

## Instructions

1. Start with a tissue box or cereal box
  - a. If using a tissue box, remove plastic film from opening
  - b. If using a cereal box, cut a hole in the box along the front or back panel (like shown in the picture)
    - i. You can make it as big as you would like, just make sure 3-5 rubber bands will fit



2. Place 3-5 rubber bands around tissue box or cereal box.
  - a. You can place them whichever way you would like!



3. If you are putting a “neck” on your guitar:
  - a. Get your paper towel roll and trace the circle on the top or bottom of the short side panel (tissue box) or the top or bottom of the box (cereal box)
  - b. Cut out the hole
  - c. Glue paper towel roll into the hole and allow to dry



4. If you DO NOT want to put a neck on your guitar, it will work just the same. You can skip step 3!
5. Decorate your guitar with markers, stickers, paint, etc.
  - a. Add anything you can to make it unique and make it YOURS!
6. After everything dries, play your new guitar to your favorite Songs and stay tuned for an activity or two using your new Instrument!
